Before the Review

- You will receive an invitation two weeks before the meeting.
- Up to date information about you will be included with the invitation.
- You can get your views ready to share at the review:
- You can give these yourself at the meeting.
- Someone can do it for you.
- You can give a list of questions that you would like answering.









At the Review

- The EHCP review meeting should be Person Centred, so it is all about you.
- It will look at what you are doing well, what could be better and what you enjoy.
- It will look at any support you need from Education, Health and Social Care Teams.
- It will look at what you want to do in the future.

Who else might be there?

Your Parent/Carer, your advocate, SENCO, Class Teacher, people supporting your health, Social Worker, SEN Casework Officer.



After the Review

- Your SEN Casework Officer will write to tell you if your EHCP will be changed
- If it is going to be changed you will be able to give feedback on these changes.
- The local authority (LA) will ask your Educational setting if they can give you the support you need. If you are moving to a different setting they will ask the same question to the new setting.
- · The LA will send you your Final Amended
- EHCP, if you don't agree with it, you/ parents/carers can appeal, detailsthat can support through this process.
