What children are learning this half term

Reception: Maths – counting, cardinal numbers, ordering/ representing numbers, sorting & comparing sizes/ mass and capacity and exploring patterns. **English/Topic** – Ourselves and our families and Autumn & Harvest **Phonics** – Phase 2 phonemes. **R.E.** – Myself & Welcome (Baptism). **RSHE**- My Happy Mind - Meet your brain. **PE** - Monday - Outdoor Explorers Autumn.

Year 1 & 2: Maths- counting and grouping objects, greater and less than, place value and identifying numbers on a number line. English- stories about pets, information texts about wild animals and poetry about animals. RE- family. History- The Gunpowder Plot. RSHE - My Happy Mind - Meet your brain.
